How to make a Will

A Will gives you peace of mind that your wishes will be carried out in the way you intended.

When including a legacy in your Will it is important that you include our name, address and charity number (see the back page of this leaflet) to prevent any uncertainty about which charity is the intended recipient of the legacy.
